Directed toward the serious player. Camp participants will be evaluated by the Texas Tech coaching staff and will receive written feedback at the end of camp.

Participants will be timed in the 60-yard sprint, be evaluated both offensively and defensively and will throw for a radar gun.

Pitchers/catchers will be evaluated, including being timed on throws to second base (catchers), bullpen and throwing in for the radar gun (pitchers/catchers). Camp will conclude with a scrimmage.

**ALL-SKILLS CAMP:**Camp Details:

Out staff will conduct individual and group instruction for all players. The campers are placed in their own age group. Groups rotate throughout the day to different stations, i.e., pitching, catching, infield, outfield, etc.

**HITTING CAMP:**Camp Details:

Focus will be on the development of each player's offensive abilities. Players will be broken down individually and coached through drill work. Each camper will be evaluated by video analysis.

**PITCHING/CATCHING CAMP:**Camp Details - Pitching Portion:

Beginning with video mechanical analysis and ranging into topics of pitch development, throwing programs, conditioning and strength training, mental game, fundamentals of defense, arm care and more. The camp will conclude with pitchers throwing live bullpens.

Camp Details - Catching Portion:

Skills and topics covered will be proper footwork, throwing mechanics, pitcher-catcher relationship, blocking and more. The camp will conclude with catchers receiving in live bullpens.

**INFIELD CAMP:**Camp Details:

Each camper will be exposed to the proper fundamentals of fielding and throwing. Campers will be put through drill work, live ground balls and game-like situations.
